SEWER CONNECTION GUIDELINES

- \* In accordance with Borough of Lehigh, Borough Code Chapter 185, Article IV, Connection Charges (also called Tapping Fee or Capital Contribution) is \$4,000.00 per EDU.
- \* Thirty (30) days to file an Application for Sewer Connection.
- \* Thirty (30) days to pay after notification of Application Approval.
- \* Non-Residential requests will be based on Gallons per Day and converted to EDU's to develop the cost.
- \* All Residential requests will be based on an EDU (Equivalent Dwelling Unit) flow value with a minimum of one (1) EDU.  

(1 EDU = 262.5 gallons/day)
- \* Flow allocations will be assigned to one location and are not transferrable to another location.
- \* Your place on the waiting list is not reassignable; i.e., if you are #1 or #2, etc. on the list, you cannot give, sell, assign, etc. your place to someone else.
- \* The time limit for using the allocation will be one (1) year from date of receiving. Time extension requests must be in writing.
- \* Your refusal at this time will require a resubmittal of request and placement at end of list.
- \* All proposed construction must meet BOCA Codes; and a Building Permit will be required.
- \* Co-ordination with all utilities, as well as Zoning, may be needed.
- \* No storm water from pavements, area ways, roofs, foundation drains or other sources shall be admitted to the sanitary sewer.
