ORDINANCE NO. 526 - 2004

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEHIGHTON, CARBON
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CHANGING THE AMOUNT OF THE
ANNUAL SEWER RENTALS FOR THE BOROUGH OF LEHIGHTON

The Borough Council of the Borough of Lehighton hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

That portion of Ordinance No. 421-1992, as subsequently amended by Ordinance No. 466-1996, Ordinance No. 496-1999 and Ordinance No. 524-2004, which is codified in Chapter 185, Article V, Section 185-32, Subsection B of the Lehighton Borough Code, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

B. Sewer rentals shall be as follows:

1. Residential Rate: \$432.00 per year.

The Residential Rate applies to each residential dwelling unit.

2. Commercial 1 Rate: \$552.00 per year.

The Commercial 1 Rate applies to all commercial establishments which use 7,500 gallons or less per month of actual water consumption on an annual average. This category includes, but is not limited to, commercial establishments which contain related residential uses utilizing the same water meter.

3. Commercial 2 Rate: \$552.00 per year plus an additional charge of \$4.00 for each additional 1,000 gallons of actual water consumption over 7,500 gallons per month.

The Commercial 2 Rate applies to all commercial establishments which use more than 7,500 gallons per month of actual water consumption on an annual average and all industrial establishments.

4. Churches: \$216.00 per year.

SECTION 2.

Chapter 185 of the Lehighton Borough Code shall, in all respects other than as specified above, remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3.

Any Ordinance or part thereof which is inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall become effective on May 1, 2004.
